

Challenges in Austria Society and farms

Lost of **4.2 m** working days due to **stress** and **depression** 2010 (Austrian Federal Association for Psychotherapy 2010)

860,000 people aged 15 and upwards are **overweight** 2006 (Austrian Health Survey 2006/07)

30,632 pupils in the school year 2014/2015 had **special educational needs** (Austrian Office for Statistics 2016)

The number of people **over 65** will increase from 1.6 m (2014) to 2.8 m (2060), **+ 75%** (*Austrian* population forecast 2015)

People suffering from **dementia**, increase from 90,500 (2000) to 260,000 in 2050, **+187%** (Dementia Report 2014)

The number of farms declined to **155,900**,-35% since Austria's membership to the EU 1995 (Agricultural structure survey 2020)

Rural migration, especially women

Price gap

Problem of finding a successor

Globalisation

Climate change




Green Care - where people flourish







Rural development 2014-2020

Funding streams Green Care, social innovation for rural areas

- Empowering rural areas and supporting policies and rural innovation
- Start 2011 as part of the rural development 2007 2013. Only "education" (M331) and Farmers (20%), no "cooperation"
- Rural development 2014 2020
 - Start "cooperation" 1. June 2015 in addition to "education"

Association Green Care Austria

- Funded measure "cooperation" (M 16.9.1)
- Funding: Eligible costs: personnel and material costs / up to 100% of eligible costs
- Farmers
 - Funded measure "diversification towards non-agricultural activities" (M 6.4.1)
 - Funding: Eligible costs: investment costs / 30% of eligible costs, cap euro 400,000 (max. euro 120,000)


